

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The State filed a motion for reciprocal discovery on July 11, 2012.
- 2. The Court granted the State's motion on July 17, 2012.
- 3. Defendant had previously failed to comply with the State's discovery request.
- 4. The State filed a motion to compel discovery on April 8, 2013.
- 5. Defendant failed to respond to that motion as well.
- 6. Defendant appeared before the Court on May 7, 2013 for a pretrial conference. At that time Defendant was admonished that he must comply with all of the discovery requests in the State's motion for reciprocal discovery.
- 7. Defendant stated he needed two weeks to respond and comply with all aspects of the State's motion for reciprocal discovery.

8. Defendant must comply with the State's motion for reciprocal discovery request by May 21, 2013.

ORDER

Based upon the State's motion, and finding good cause, it is hereby ordered that Defendant must respond to and comply with all aspects of the State's motion for reciprocal discovery. Any discovery not submitted to the State by May 21, 2013 will be excluded from Defendant's jury trial.
