I HAVEN'T SEEN THEM IN 90 DAYS AND DID NOT FEEL IT APPROPRIATE FOR MY CHILDREN TO SEE ME THROUGH A MONITOR.

I RESPECTFULLY ASK YOU FOR A STATUS REPORT IN THIS CASE. MY WIFE HAS HER HANDS FULL AND IS ANXIOUS TO GET ME HOME TO MY FAMILY.
